

How important is good quality data to your business?

It has long been agreed that data is an essential corporate asset, second only to people. In order for your business to maximise the investment in its assets, a structured programme of management and maintenance is required.

This is particularly true for data assets, as your business is constantly making decisions based on the information and knowledge derived from that data.

The importance of data quality can never be underestimated. Incomplete and inaccurate data will adversely impact all elements of your business. In today's e-enabled market place growth and diversity is dependant on data quality. It is sometimes difficult to begin addressing data quality issues as the topic is often seen as the proverbial "can of worms".

However, by beginning to identify the scope and impact of poor quality data, it is possible to produce a structured plan to address Data Quality Management.

Data Quality issues can manifest themselves in a number of ways. Often the financial impact of poor quality data on day-to-day business operations is unknown. However, when viewed in the context of a data migration project, poor data quality will jeopardise the delivery of the project. Too often migration projects make assumptions about source data only to find that the reality is something quite different – the bottom line is knowing the "truth" about your data at the start which will avoid expensive revelations later in the project.

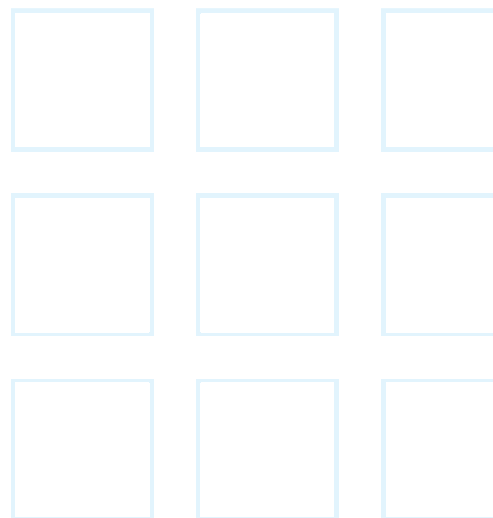
