- **Introduction to WebIntelligence** – an overview of the environment
- **Viewing Documents** – logging in to WebIntelligence and logging out, viewing existing documents in InfoView, how to get help, search for documents, configuring the InfoView environment
- **Creating Documents** – creating new documents with queries, how to edit and run queries, how to save and print documents, create and assign categories to personal documents, configure list options, change your password
- **Restricting Data** – how to apply and group filters to restrict the amount of data returned from the database by a query
- **Displaying Information** – how to use tables and charts in WebIntelligence to display the information in different ways, and how to use formatting to present data to best effect
- **Enhancing Reports** – how to use built-in functions to add value to your displayed data, including sorts, filters, calculations, ranking and alerters; how to sub-group data using breaks and sections
- **Functions** – how to create formulae and variables and apply them to your report
- **Analysing Data** – Analysing data from different levels of detail and zoom in on important trends in your business
- **Multiple Universes** – how to synchronise data from multiple universes to produce tables of combined data; learn the rules for synchronisation
- **Sharing Documents** – how to distribute your WebIntelligence documents to colleagues
